We completed most of the *Moral Tales* curriculum from the UUA *Tapestry of Faith* program.

Our students have participated in many Sunday services, including the four solstice and equinox services, the "blessing of the animals" service, and a service during which they gave several readings. They have also introduced the *Change for Change* social justice fundraising program to the fellowship (led by Lisa), read several of the Stories for All Ages, started a children's choir (led by Gretchen), sung with the All God's Children Choir, and may attend BUUF's first weeklong summer camp this coming July (led by Joanne).
