Endowment Video

- .Endowment is an investment account that BUUFers can contribute to, usually after death
- When endowment investments perform well, the fund grows
- .We have rules on how the growing funds can be used
- Some of the endowment funds can never be touched
- Some of the growth must be used for BUUF's social & environmental justice projects
- Some of the growth can be used for general operating expenses
- Certain special projects meet the criteria for fund use
- While it is good to have the endowment as a nice savings account, it has its disadvantages

Endowment Video

- Currently we use about \$7,400 of our endowment growth for general operating expenses each year
- Another \$2,700 is earmarked each year for social & environmental justice projects

- .Misc supplies—not usually quantified

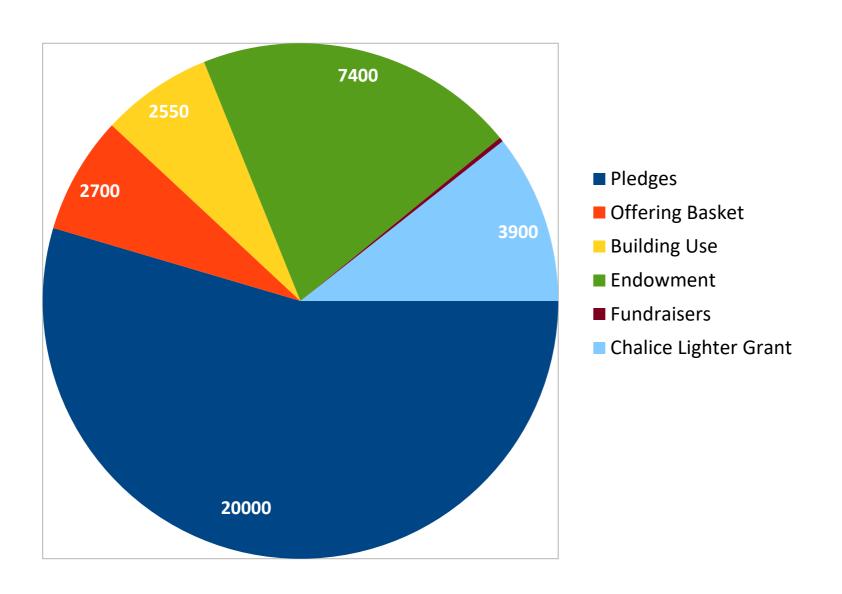

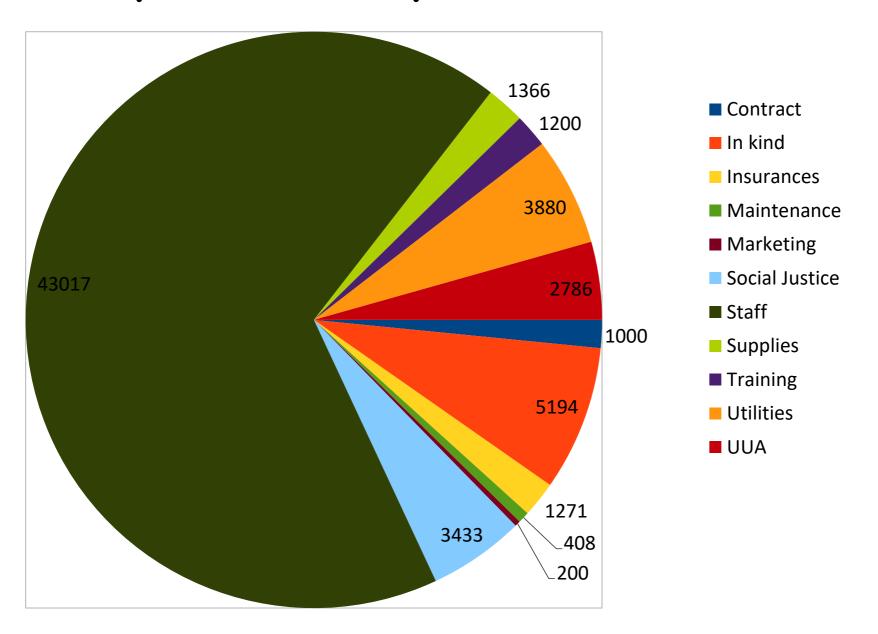
