Sunday Services team mission (established 7/21/19): "Support the creation of meaningful services that flow smoothly, embody our liberal religious heritage, and engage the entire congregation."

Accomplishments:

- -Introduced monthly Sunday Service themes
- -Encouraged Whole Congregation Worship during first half of each Sunday Service, with a goal of engaging children to promote their UU identity.
- -Established weekly Greeter for in person services
- -Transitioned in March from In-Person to Virtual services due to COVID-19 pandemic
- -Surveyed Zoom participants for input on virtual Sunday Services

2020-2021 Goals:

Produce meaningful weekly Sunday Services that flow smoothly, embody our UU values, and engage the entire congregation:

- Explore and implement best practices for Zoom services
 - Improve speaker presentation skills:
 - How to: Look at the camera; Arrange for a neutral or uncluttered background; Address lighting (for lip reading, etc); Ensure clear speech; Follow script/Order of Service; and other improvements as needed.
 - Improve participant etiquette during gathering, service, social time and circle talk:
 - Muted microphone, raising hand to speak
 - Improve presentation process
 - Utilize moderator/stage manager
 - Limit disruptive/jarring sounds and visuals
 - Consider Order of Service format changes to adapt to virtual medium
- Attract and develop skilled lay speakers and lay leaders (Shared Pulpit, etc)
- Engage children in virtual and in person services
- Determine best way to continue streaming services once in-person services are resumed

Budgetary Needs:

The Rev. Jim McConnell: Per contract, 2-3 services per month

Guest speakers: \$150 per service, 4-5 services per year

Music Directors: \$15 per hour, 5 hours per week
