Your pledge of financial support for Berrien Unitarian Universalist Fellowship makes it possible to:

- Conduct 52 Sunday services every year, providing a welcoming worship space for those who share our principles but may feel abandoned by mainstream religion due to their beliefs, sexual orientation, political leanings, etc.
- Host hybrid services most Sundays to reach our members and friends who are out of town or unable to join services in person, maintaining our community despite our distance.
- Provide children's religious education and intergenerational services building a new generation of loving, thoughtful, open-minded, principled leaders
- Offer educational and thought-provoking events that are open to the community, including the Environmental Justice Film Series, Mindfulness Workshops, Community Conversations, Small Group Ministry and more
- Provide pastoral care for members and friends as they face life's myriad changes, including marriage, parenting, illness, divorce or separation, financial problems or the passing of loved ones
- Serve over 1000 meals at the Benton Harbor Soup Kitchen each year
- Provide a meeting space for community organizations such as the Citizens Climate Lobby, All God's Children Choir, Southwest Michigan Interfaith Action Council, get-out-the-vote efforts, etc.
- Provide space for visionary Green Sanctuary initiatives that others might adopt, including a solar array, organic children's garden, battery-powered lawn mower and native plantings
- Pay a fair wage to our small, part-time staff who manage the fellowship's operations
- Bring together a small but passionate community to collectively advocate for a more life-affirming, democratic, sustainable society, achieving more together than we might ever achieve alone

Pledge your Financial and/or In-kind Support

The cost of running our fellowship is approximately \$50,000/year. This includes the cost a part-time minister, RE director, office administrator, music director, and childcare. It also covers utilities, insurance, snow plowing, repairs, office, kitchen and RE supplies, and social justice initiatives. We accomplish a lot on a very thin budget! In the coming year, we are also hoping to host Our Whole Lives programming, fund additional guest speakers, and improve our grounds and facilities.

When we commit to financial support, we affirm our belief in this community, its principles and each other, and we engage in the spiritual art of giving. The UUA recommends that members pledge a "fair-share" contribution of 2 to 10% of income. Those not giving at this level currently may want to consider it a goal to strive for over the coming years.
